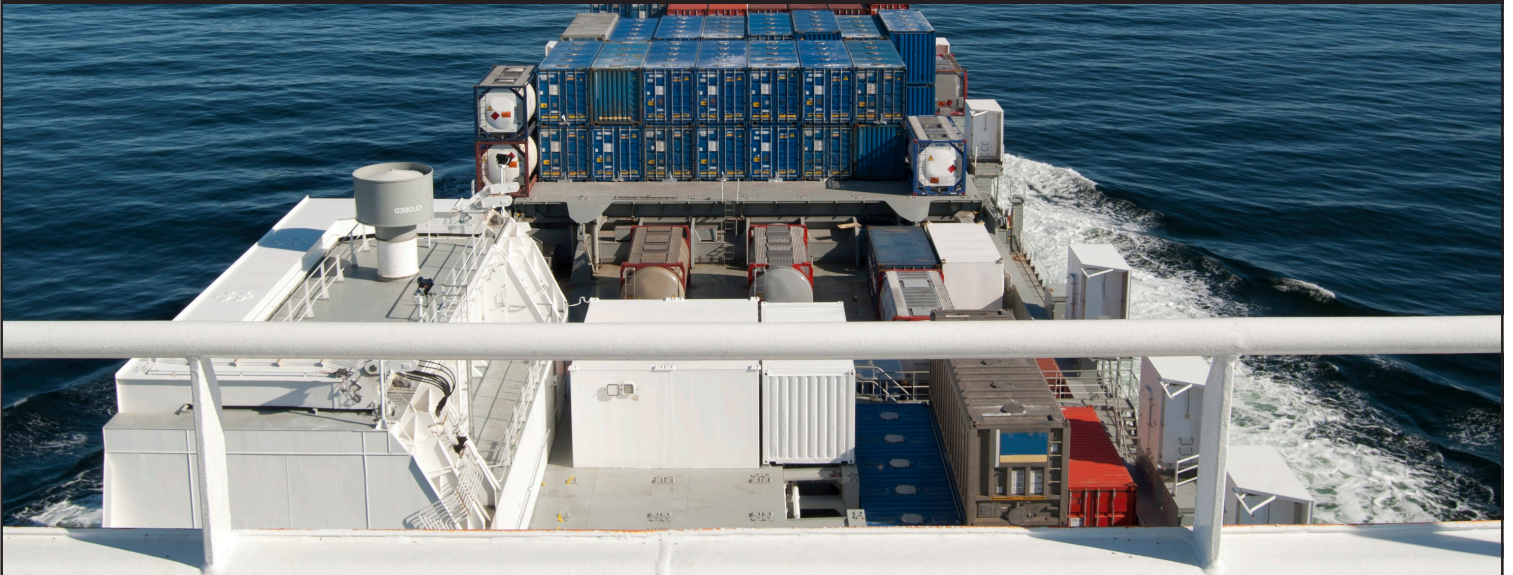

Lopolight ensures that all spare parts for your navigation light solution, including installation guides are on board your vessel. The spare parts are replenished automatically as long as the subscription is kept

– truly lights for life.



LIGHTS FOR LIFE DESCRIPTION

Lopolight will make a high quality yellow pelicase available with spare parts for all lights onboard (a practical maximum of 8 different types), and spare parts for the NLC together with a troubleshooting guide and installation instructions. The pelicase will be kept always updated, with Lopolight shipping replenishment items free of charge.

The Lights for Life (L-4-L) program is offered for installations with Lopolight Navigation Lights and Lopolight Navigation Light Controller only.



CONTENTS:

The case content is specific to the installation on the individual vessel and will as a minimum contain:

- 1 pc. Masthead light, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. Starboard sidelight, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. Port sidelight, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. Stern light, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. White 360°, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. Red 360°, double or single – light only
- 1 pc. Base for light
- 6 pc. Cable glands, blanking nuts and lock screws
- 2 pc. Monitoring relays (LMR/Q) for NLC
- 4 pc. 5-pin and 3-pin Connectors for lights and NLC

- Troubleshooting manual
- Installation manuals for lights and LMR/Q cards
- Instructions for raising a warranty claim.

DETAILS:

L-4-L is a Subscription based service; monthly subscription fee based on the system list price. When items from case is used, the crew fill's out a warranty claim form (online at www.lopolight.com) and Lopolight sends a free of charge replacement part to the address specified.

Subscription minimum length is 36 months, there is no maximum length.

Subscription is vessel specific. The case and contents remain property of Lopolight and to be returned when subscription ends.
